

What is your responsibility as a delegate?

- The county assembly is convened to designate county candidates for the primary election and to select delegates to the congressional district assemblies and the state assembly.
- The delegates also nominate candidates for Congress, the Colorado General Assembly, the State Board of Education, the Board of Regents, and District Attorneys when these positions are on the ballot.
- The purpose of the state assembly is to nominate candidates for statewide offices to the primary election ballot. During the assembly, delegates will also be elected to the national convention.
- The Douglas County Democratic Party has determined that we will have no limit on the number of delegates at our County Assembly. We hope that this will encourage more and more people to participate in the democratic process. We will be allowed 224 delegates to the State Assembly.
